



FOUR paw-fect reasons to license your dog (WOOF):

1. It's the Law

2. It Helps if Your Dog Goes Missing

A dog license has a unique ID number that's tied to their owner. The license number can be used to identify the owner and facilitate a happy reunion!

3. It Proves Your Dog Has Been Vaccinated

When a dog is licensed, proof of a current rabies vaccination is required. Therefore, a license tag is proof of a dog being rabies-free.

4. It Even Helps Stray Pets Find Homes

Fees from dog licenses help <u>local shelters and animal control organizations</u> provide food and services to stray pets. That means more pets get the care and attention they deserve.

January 1	Dog Licenses Available at the Town Clerk's Office
April 1	Registration Deadline- bring a copy of your dog's latest rabies certificate & spayed/neutered certificate (for first time registries only). Cost is \$9 for spayed/neutered and \$11 for non-spayed/intact
After April 1	LATE FEE APPLIES: \$2 for spayed/neutered and \$4 for non-spayed/intact

<u>Charlotte Ordinance Regarding Nuisance Animals</u> requires owners to maintain control of their dogs at all times!
